Both parties HAVE AGREED as follows.

**Objective:**

To collaborate on community engagement and service initiatives that enable students to apply theoretical knowledge to real-world problems, promoting social responsibility, community participation, and active citizenship, while addressing societal needs and fostering sustainable development.

The parties subject to the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding and the laws, rules, regulations, and national policies from time to time in force, agree to strengthen, promote, and develop cooperation in the field of preclinical research using animal models between the two institutions.

**Areas of Cooperation**

Each party will be subject to the laws, rules, and regulations, and endeavor to take the necessary steps to encourage and promote cooperation in the following areas and/or forms.

1. Community-based projects: Collaborative projects that address local issues, such as environmental conservation, animal welfare, and social development.
2. Student internships and training: Providing students with hands-on experience and training in community engagement, research, and project management.
3. Research and development: Joint research initiatives that focus on solving local problems and developing innovative solutions.
4. Capacity building: Training and capacity-building programs for students, faculty, and community members on topics such as community engagement, project management, and social responsibility.
5. Community outreach and awareness: Collaborative efforts to raise awareness about social and environmental issues, promote community engagement, and foster social responsibility.
6. Skill development and vocational training: Programs that equip students and community members with skills and knowledge that enhance their employability and socio-economic status.
7. Event organization and management: Joint organization of events, workshops, and conferences that promote community engagement, social responsibility, and sustainable development.

These areas of cooperation can help achieve the objectives of the MoU and create a positive impact on the community, while also enhancing the learning experience and social awareness of students.

### **Protection of Intellectual Property Rights**

- a) The protection of intellectual property rights shall be enforced in conformity with the national laws, rules and regulations.
- b) Notwithstanding anything in paragraph(a) above the intellectual property right in respect of any technological development and any product and services Development carried out.
  - i) Jointly by the parties or research result obtained through the joint activity effort by the parties shall be jointly owned by the parties in accordance with the terms to be mutually agreed upon and
  - ii) The terms and condition in the execution of the research projects shall be decided on case-to-case basis.

### **Revision, Modification and Amendment**

- (a) Either party may request in writing a revision, modification or amendment or all or any part of this Memorandum of Understanding.
- (b) Any revision, modification or amendment agreed to by the parties shall be reduced into writing and shall form part of this Memorandum of Understanding.
- (c) Any revision, modification or amendment shall not prejudice the rights and obligations arising from or based on this Memorandum of Understanding Prior or up to the date of such revision, modification or amendment.

### **Entry into Force, Duration, and Termination**

- a) This Memorandum of Understanding shall come into force on the date of signing and shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years. Willingness to extend the MOU for a specified period may be initiated six months in advance and further agreed upon by both parties.
- b) The termination of this Memorandum of Understanding shall not affect the implementation of ongoing activities and/or Programmes which have been agreed upon before the date of the termination of this Memorandum of Understanding.

Terms and Conditions-

- The institute will provide the infrastructure, faculty of the department.
- The participation fees will not be charged for this program.


