### **About Shri Shivaji Science College, Amravati, (MS)India:**

Shri Shivaji Science College, Amravati, is an educational institution run by the Shri Shivaji Education Society, Amravati. The college was established in 1969. Now, Shri Shivaji Science College, Amravati, has evolved as a premier institution for imparting formal education in the science stream and is affiliated with Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati. The college offers Junior, undergraduate, postgraduate, and research-level education, career-oriented courses, and B.Voc. Courses are also part of the faculty of science. The college is re-accredited by NAAC with 'A' Grade with a CGPA of 3.42(Fourth Cycle). Our institution has achieved numerous accolades, including NAAC A+ grade with a CGPA of 3.42, PM USHA Component-3 Grant, UGC's College with Potential for Excellence (CPE) status, Rank 93 in NIRF 2025, DBT's STAR College Scheme, DST's FIST support, ISO 9001:2015 certification, recognition as a Lead College by SGBAU, and designation as a Centre of Excellence under Career Katta. (Hereinafter referred to as 'the institute')

### **About Nature Conservation Society, Amravati**

The Nature Conservation Society, Amravati (NCSA) is a non-profit organization working tirelessly to protect wildlife and biodiversity in central India. Through a collaborative approach, NCSA focuses on education, research, and conservation efforts, engaging with various stakeholders to promote nature and wildlife preservation, rather than relying on confrontational methods. The organization works to protect natural resources in and around wildlife areas in India by educating the masses, especially the young generation, about the importance of nature conservation, and collaborating with local communities, law enforcement agencies, policymakers, and academic institutions to design and implement conservation projects, while also engaging with government departments and pursuing critical issues through the judiciary to safeguard the environment and ecosystems.(Hereinafter referred to as 'NCSA')

### **Objectives of this MoU**

1. To work jointly to make the students and faculty of the department aware of various issues related to ecology, environment, forest, and wildlife conservation, and provide them opportunities to seek solutions by effectively addressing these issues.
2. To create an environment for undertaking minor and major research projects/ field projects by the faculty and students of the department on topics related to forest and ecology.
3. To provide paid / unpaid internship opportunities to the students of life sciences and environmental sciences.
4. To design and execute various training /certification programs related to ecology and environment for the students.

### **Areas of Cooperation**

Each party, in accordance with the laws, rules, and regulations, shall endeavor to take necessary steps to encourage and promote co-operation in the following areas and/or forms.

1. Joint Conservation Projects: Collaborative initiatives to protect and conserve wildlife and natural habitats.
2. Research and Studies: Joint research projects on environmental conservation, wildlife protection, and ecosystem management.
3. Community Engagement and Education: Educational programs and workshops to raise awareness about nature conservation and promote sustainable practices.
4. Capacity Building: Training and capacity-building programs for students, faculty, and community members on conservation and environmental management.
5. Internships and Field Experience: Providing students with hands-on experience and training in conservation and environmental management.
6. Policy and Advocacy: Collaborative efforts to inform policy and advocacy initiatives related to nature conservation and environmental protection.

These areas of cooperation can help promote nature conservation, support research and education, and foster community engagement and participation in conservation efforts

## **1. Protection of Intellectual Property Rights**

- a) The protection of intellectual property rights shall be enforced in conformity with the national laws, rules and regulations.
- b) Notwithstanding anything in paragraph(a) above the intellectual property right in respect of any technological development and any product and services Development carried out.
  - i) Jointly by the parties or research result obtained through the joint activity effort by the parties shall be jointly owned by the parties in accordance with the terms to be mutually agreed upon and
  - ii) The terms and condition in the execution of the research projects shall be decided on case-to-case basis.

## **Revision, Modification and Amendment**

- (a) Either party may request in writing a revision, modification or amendment or all or any part of this Memorandum of Understanding.
- (b) Any revision, modification or amendment agreed to by the parties shall be reduced into writing and shall form part of this Memorandum of Understanding.
- (c) Any revision, modification or amendment shall not prejudice the rights and obligations arising from or based on this Memorandum of Understanding Prior or up to the date of such revision, modification or amendment.

## **Entry into Force, Duration, and Termination**

- a) This Memorandum of Understanding shall come into force on the date of signing and shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years. Willingness to extend the MOU for a specified period may be initiated six months in advance and further agreed upon by both parties.
- b) The termination of this Memorandum of Understanding shall not affect the implementation of ongoing activities and/or Programmes which have been agreed upon before the date of the termination of this Memorandum of Understanding.

Terms and Conditions-


- The institute will provide the infrastructure and faculty of the department.
- The institute/NCSA shall not charge any participation fees for the awareness programs, field activities, etc.
- The charges for certification programs, training programs, workshops, etc., designed especially for the benefit of the student community, shall be jointly decided by the department/ institute and NCSA





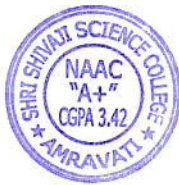
